O R B E R:

In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued for extension of the scheme of Free Education to the First Generation students belonging to Most Backward Classes and Donotified Communities, whose parental annual income does not exceed Rs.12,000/- and who pursue studies in Professional Degree Courses viz. Medical, Engineering, Law Agriculture, Veterinary from 1990-91 onwards.

2. In the Government Order third read above, the scheme of Free Education was extended to the first generation students belonging to Backward Classes and whose parental annual income does not exceed Rs. 12,000/- upto Degree Courses from 1990-91 onwards.

3. The Government as a further concession for Backward Classes, decided to extend the free education scheme upto Professional courses. They, accordingly, direct that the

Scheme of Free Education upto Professional Degree Courses such as Medical, Engineering, Law, Agriculture, Veterinary etc. be extended to the students belonging to Backward Classes from the academic year 1991-92 subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) Either of the parents or any of the brothers/sisters should not be a Graduate.
- 11) Parental annual income should not exceed Rs.12,000/-

The students covered under the scheme of Free Education are exempted from payment of tuition fees, special fees, other compulsory fees and Examination fees.

4. This scheme of Free Education is also applicable to the students studying Professional Courses in Self-Financing Colleges admitted under Government quota. They shall be paid at the rates prescribed by the Director of Technical Education, Director of Legal Studies, Director of Medical Education etc. for Government colleges and not the actual amount collected by the Self-Financing Institutions.

5. The Government sanction a sum of Rs.9.6 lakhs (Rupees nine lakhs and sixty thousands only) towards implementation of the scheme of Free Education to First Generation Backward Classes upto Professional Degree Courses.

6. The expenditure is on 'New Service' and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. Orders will be issued by the Finance (BG.I) Department to this effect. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare is requested to send suitable proposals in the prescribed proforma to Finance (BG.I) under intimation to this Department along with a copy of this order.
