SOCIAL WELFARE Welfare of Backward Classes - Education - opening of 11 new hostels for Backward Classes students Sanctioned.

ORDER:-

In continuation of the orders issued in the G.O. first read above, the Government sanction the opening of 11 (eleven) new hostels for Backward Classes students during 1971-72. The location of the hostels and their strength are detailed in the annexure to this order.

2. The Government also sanction the employment of the staff detailed in the Annexure to this order for the period from the date of employment to 29.2.1972. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of the other items of expenditure as detailed in the Annexure to this order in respect of the new Government hostels ordered to be opened in para 1 above. The staff excluding cooks and watchman-cum-servants will be eligible to draw the usual Dearness Allowances and other Allowances admissible under the orders in force.

3. The expenditure is on a Plan scheme eligible for Central assistance. The Director of Backward Classes is requested to include the expenditure in the quarterly statement of expenditure on Plan Schemes which will be submitted by him for claiming central assistance.

4. The expenditure should be debited to "39, & Misc. Social and Developmental Organisations.c. Welfare of Scheduled Tribes and Castes and Other Backward Classes.d. Development schemes-Schemes in the Fourth Five Year Plan.(ii) Schemes financed partly by the Union Government-Schemes under the control of the Director of Backward Classes A. Backward Classes-4. Opening and maintenance of hostels".

5. The Director of Backward Classes is however requested to restrict the total expenditure on the opening of 50 new hostels sanctioned in the G.O. read first above and in this order to the budget allocation of Rs. 6, 91,700/- during the current year.
