ABSTRACT:- S.W. - Welfare of B.Gs - Education - Opening of new hostels for Backward Classes students during 1975-76 - Sanctioned.

READ:- From the D3C, 1r.No.39/11337/75 dt.10/4/75 and dt. 21/4/75.

ORDER:

The Government sanction the opening of 10 (ten) new hostels for Backward Classes for High School students during 1975-76. The location of the hostels and their strength are detailed in the annexure to this order. 1

2. The Government also sanction the employment of staff, as detailed in the annexure to this order for the period upto 31-3-76 from the date of employment or till the need ceases; 1
whichever is earlier. 1

3. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of other items of expenditure as detailed in the annexure to this order in respect of the new Government Hostels ^{for High School students} ordered to be opened in paragraph 1 above.

4. The staff excluding the Cooks and Watchman-cum-Servants will be eligible to draw the usual dearness allowance and other allowances admissible under the orders in force.

5. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of the following items of expenditure:-

1. Vessels, Furniture Rs.1500/- (Rupees thousand) for each hostel
2. Rent ~~at~~ for each bldg. Rs.100/- (Rupees hundred) in which hostel for High school students is located. only) per month.
6. The expenditure should be debited to "088.Social Security and Welfare - C.Welfare of S.Gs., STs and O.B.G.s - D.Welfare of B.Gs. - AD. B.G. Hostels."

7. ~~The D B C is informed that orders regarding opening of another ten hostels will be issued separately.~~

7. The D.B.C. ~~is~~ informed that a sum of Rs.4.10 lakhs has been provided in the Budget Estimate for 1975-76 for opening of 20³3.3. hostels together with supply of clothing to the boarders. He is requested to ensure that the expenditure for opening of new hostels and supply of clothing to the boarders should not on any account exceed the budget provision of Rs.4.10 lakhs during 1975-76.
