ORDER:

In G.O.Ms.No.541, Social Welfare, dated 30.6.1976 the Government sanctioned the opening of a Backward Classes Girls Hostel at Thirumangalam in Thanjavur District with a strength of 50 boarders during 1976-77. The Director of Backward Classes has reported that against the sanctioned strength of 50 boarders only 7 girl students were found to be eligible for admission from out of the 73 girl students who applied for admission. He has therefore recommended the closure of the hostel at Thirumangalam. In this connection he has reported that in the High School at Kuttalam there are 1061 boys and girls out of which 303 girls are eligible for hostel admission. He has therefore recommended that the hostel proposed to be closed at Thirumangalam may be shifted to Kuttalam. He has indicated that no extra cost involved by the opening of a hostel at Kuttalam.

2. The Government accept the recommendation of the Director of Backward Classes and direct that the Hostel opened for the Backward Classes ~~Ms~~ Girls ~~Hostel~~ at Thirumanaglam with reference to the orders issued in the G.O. read above be closed. Sanction is also accorded for opening a girls' hostel for the High School at Kuttalam with a strength of 50 boarders with the staff and other items of expenditure sanctioned for the hostel at Thirumangalam with effect from the academic year 1976-77. The Director of Backward Classes is informed that no extra cost should be incurred by opening a girls hostel at Kuttalam over and above the expenditure sanctioned for the hostel at Thirumanaglam.

3. The expenditure should debited to "288. Social Security Welfare - C.Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes - ae. Welfare of other Backward Classes - Schemes in the Fifth Five Year Plan - II.State Plan - JA. Backward Classes hostel. (D.P.Code 288C AEJA 0008).



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4. The action of the Director of Backward Classes in having permitted the Collector, Thanjavur to close the Backward Classes Girls' Hostel at Thirumangalam and to open a new hostel at Kuttalam in anticipation of approval of Government. is ratified. Hereafter, the Director of Backward Classes should finalise the proposal of opening a new hostel only after thorough consideration of utilisation in the particular place where a hostel is proposed to be opened.
