ORDER:

The Government sanction the opening of two College Boys hostels and eighteen School Boys/Girls hostels for Backward Classes and Denotified Communities students during the year 1985-86. The location of the hostels and their strength are detailed in the Annexure to this order.

2. The Government also sanction the employment of staff as detailed in the Annexure to this order from the date of employment till the need therefor ceases and also subject to the condition that the strength of boarders of each hostel is maintained at the same level. The staff will be eligible to draw in addition to pay the usual allowances admissible to them under the orders in force.

3. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of other items of expenditure as detailed below and as detailed in the Annexure to this order in respect of the new hostels ordered to be opened in paragraph one above:-

I. Vessels and furniture including alarm time piece for the High School students and Wall Clock for College students hostels:-

- i) For High School students hostels at the rate of Rs.6,200/- per each of the 18 High School students hostels.
- ii) For College Boys hostels at the rate of Rs.6,350/- per each of the 2 College students hostels.

II. Rent for building:

For the 18 High School and 2 College students hostels not exceeding Rs.300/- p.m. per hostel. (The rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed by the Director of Backward Classes in consultation with the Public Works Authorities).

4. The Government also accept the recommendation of Director of Backward Classes for supply of dresses to the boarders in the 18 (eighteen) High School students Hostels. They accordingly sanction the supply of dresses to 900 (18x50) (Nine hundred only) High School boarders at the rate of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty only) per boarder to the Backward Classes High School students hostels ordered to be opened during 1985-86.

5. The Director of Backward Classes is requested to arrange for the purchase of requisite varieties of cloth in consultation with Director of Handlooms, Madras.

6. The Director of Handlooms, Madras is requested to assist the Director of Backward Classes in the purchase of the requisite varieties of cloth at the lowest rate possible, having regard to the bulk order to be placed by the Director of Backward Classes, Madras, as the clothes are intended for supply to poor Backward Classes students.

7. The Director of Backward Classes is informed that the garments should be got stitched by the Tailoring Units under the control of the Director of Social Welfare.

8. The expenditure other than the supply of clothings should be debited to "288.Social Security and Welfare - C.Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes - AE.Welfare of Other Backward Classes - Schemes in the Seventh Five Year Plan - II.State Plan - JA.Backward Classes Hostels". (D.P.Code 288C AEJA 0008). The expenditure in respect of supply of clothing to the inmates of Backward Classes hostels should be debited to "288.Social Security and Welfare - C.Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes - AE.Welfare of Other Backward Classes - Schemes in the Seventh Five Year Plan - II.State Plan - JB.Clothing to the boarders in Backward Classes Hostels - 27. Clothing and Equipments" (D.P.Code 288C AEJB 2706). The expenditure in respect of Denotified Communities hostels including supply of clothing to the inmates should be debited to, "288.Social Security and Welfare-

C.Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes - AD.Welfare of Denotified and Nomadic Tribes - Schemes in the Seventh Five Year Plan - II, State Plan - CJE. Denotified Communities hostels" (D.P.Code 288C ADJE 2704).

9. The Director of Backward Classes is requested to ensure that the expenditure is restricted within the Budget provision available under Budget Estimate 1985-86.
