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ORDER:

The Government accord sanction to the opening of 25 hostels for High School students belonging to Backward Classes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities (20 Boys Hostel + 5 Girls Hostels) during the year 1989-90 in accordance with the avowed policy of the Government to provide boarding and lodging facilities to the poor students of the weaker sections of the society for prosecuting their Pre-metric studies without any drop out/break in the middle of their courses. The strength of each hostel will be 50. Orders regarding the location of the 25 hostels will be issued separately.

2. The Government also sanction the employment of the staff and to the incurring of other attendant items of expenditure (both recurring and non-recurring) for the 25 New hostels to be opened, as detailed in the annexure to this order, from the date of opening of these hostels or till the need therefore ceases subject to the condition that the strength of boarders of each hostel is maintained at the same level.

3. The staff will be eligible to draw in addition to their basic pay the dearness allowances and other allowances at the rates admissible to them under the orders in force.

4. The Government also accord sanction for the supply of dresses to 1250 (25 X 50) (one thousand two hundred and fifty only) High School boarders at the rate of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty only) per boarder to the 25 Backward Classes students hostels ordered to be opened during 1989-90.

5. The Director of Backward Classes is requested to arrange for the purchase of requisite varieties of cloth in consultation with the Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras.

6. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras is requested to assist the Director of Backward Classes, Madras in the purchase of the requisite varieties of cloth at the lowest rate possible, having regard to the bulk order to be placed by the Director of Backward Classes, Madras as the clothes are intended for supply ~~of~~ to poor Backward Classes students.

7. The Director of Backward Classes is informed that the garments should be got stitched by the Tailoring Units under the control of the Director of Social Welfare.

8. The expenditure other than the supply of clothings, should be debited to, 2225, Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes-03. Welfare of Backward Classes-277. Education - Schemes in the Seventh Five Year Plan-II. State Plan-JJ. Backward Classes Hostels". (D.P Code No.2225 03 277 JJ/ 0000). *06, Rent, rates & Taxes*

9. The expenditure in respect of supply of clothing to the inmates of Backward Classes hostels should be debited, "2225. Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes-03. Welfare of Backward Classes-277. Education-Schemes in the Seventh Five Year Plan-II. State Plan-JK. Clothing to the Boarders in Backward Classes Hostels-27. Clothing and Equipments" (D.P.Code No.2225 03 277 JK 2702)

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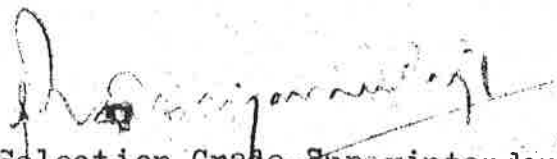

STAFF DETAILS AND OTHER ITEMS OF EXPENDITURE

- i) 20 B.T./B.Ed. Grade Wardents and 5 B.T./B.Ed. Grade Matrons in the scale of pay of Rs.780-35-1025-40-1385.
- ii) 25 Cooks in the scale of pay of Rs.350-10-550 plus free meals for the period during which the hostel functions.
- iii) 25 helpers to assist the Cooks on a consolidated pay of Rs.70/- p.m. for the period during which the hostel functions. The Director of Backward Classes is requested to follow the same procedure now being followed in the appointments of part time workers in the Noon Meal Centres. The terms and conditions of appointment of Part Time helpers, will be issued separately.
- iv) 5 Watchman-cum-Servants in the scale of pay of Rs.450-10-570-15-720.
- v) Food charges at Rs.85/- p.m. for 10 months for High School Boys boarders and food charges for High School Girls boarders at Rs.86/-p.m. for 10 months inclusive of Re.1/- towards toilet charges.
- vi) Miscellaneous expenditure at Rs.2/- p.m. per boarder (both boys and girls)
- vii) Food charges at Rs.85/- per cook for 10 months.
- viii) Vessels and furniture including Alarm Time Piece for the High School students hostels of the rate of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) for each of the 25 hostels.
- ix) Rent not exceeding Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) per month per hostel (the rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed by the Director of Backward Classes in consultation with the Public Works Department authorities).
- x) Mats for 1250 boarders at Rs.11/- per boarder.
