ORDER:

The Government accord sanction to the opening  
of 50 High School/College hostels as in the Annexure-II  
to this order during the year 1990-91 in accordance  
with the avowed policy of the Government to provide  
boarding and lodging facilities to the poor students  
of the weaker sections of the society to prosecute  
their studies without any break in the middle of  
their course. The strength of each hostel will be 50.

2. The Government also sanction the employment  
of the staff and to the incurring of other attendant  
items of the expenditure (both recurring and non-recurring)  
for the 50 new hostels to be opened as detailed in the  
Annexure-I to this order from the date of opening of these  
hostels or till the need therefor ceases subject to the

condition that the strength of the boarders of each hostels is maintained at the same level.

3. The staff will be eligible to draw in addition to their basic pay, the Dearness Allowance and other allowances at the rates admissible to them under the orders in force.

4. The Government also accord sanction for the supply of dresses to 2100 (50 x 42) (two thousand and one hundred only) boarders @ Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred only) per boarder in the High School hostels to be opened during 1990-91 as detailed in Annexure-II to this order.

5. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are requested to arrange for the purchase of requisite variety of cloth in consultation with the Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras.

6. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras is requested to assist the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Madras in the purchase of the requisite varieties of the cloth at the lowest rate possible, having regard to the bulk orders to be placed by the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Madras as the clothes are intended for the supply to poor students.

7. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are informed that the garments should be got stitched by the tailoring units under the control of the Director of Social Welfare.

8. The expenditure shall be debited as follows:-

1) Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare:

(a) Expenditure other than supply of clothing.

A N N E X U R E - I

Staff details and other items of expenditure under both the Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities.

1. 35 B.T./B.Ed. Grade Wardens and 15 B.T./B.Ed. Grade Matrons in the scale of pay of Rs.1400-40-1600-50-2300-60-2600. (For Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare - 4 Wardens and 11 Matrons and for Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities - 26 Wardens and 9 Matrons).
2. 50 Cooks on a consolidated pay of Rs.500/- plus free meals for the period during which hostel functions (Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare - 15 posts and Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities - 35 posts).
3. 50 Helpers to assist the Cooks on a consolidated pay of Rs.70/- p.m. for the period during which the hostel functions. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are requested to follow the same procedure now being followed in the appointments of part time workers in the Noon Meal Centres. (Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare - 15 Helpers and Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities - 35 Helpers).
4. 25 posts of Watchmen-cum-Servants in the scale of pay of Rs.750-12-870-14-940 for High School Girls Hostel and College/I.T.I. hostel. (Under Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare 12 posts and 13 posts under Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities).
5. Food charges at Rs.85/-p.m. for High School Boys and Girls boarders and Rs.135/- p.m. for College/I.T.I. boarders (Moffusil) and Rs.140/- p.m. for College/I.T.I. boarders in Madras City for 8 months.
6. Miscellaneous expenditure at Rs.2/- per boarder (both boys and Girls).
7. Vessels and furniture for students and amenities for hostels at the rate of Rs.59,175/- per hostel.
8. Rent not exceeding Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) p.m. per Boys and Girls Hostel and Rs.1,500/- (Rupees One thousand five hundred only) per month per I.T.I./College hostel. The rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed in consultation with Public Works Department authorities.

9. Mats at a rate of Rs.15/- per student in each hostel.
10. To incur a non-recurring expenditure not exceeding Rs.14,000/- (Rupees Fourteen thousand only) towards the installation of Indane/Dharat/H.P. Cooking Gas connection, deposit etc. if such facilities are available in the places where hostels are to be opened during 1990-91 (vide Annexure-II) and a recurring expenditure of Rs.6,000/- p.a. towards the consumption of cooking gas per hostel. A report may be sent to Government indicating the hostels provided with Indane Gas connections.
11. To incur a non-recurring expenditure of Rs.6,000/- (Rupees Six thousand only) per hostel for the purchase of Wet Grinders. The procedures indicated in para 4 of the G.O.Ms.No.100, Backward Classes and Most Backward Classes Welfare, dated 24.5.90 may be followed in this case.
