ORDER:-

The Government accord sanction for the opening
of 20 Girls hostels (2 Backward Classes College Girls hostels,
8 Backward Classes School hostels, 8 Most Backward Classes
School hostels and 2 Denotified Communities school hostels)
at the places as in Annexure-II to this order during the
year 1993-94 to provide boarding and lodging facilities to the
poor students of the weaker sections of the society to
prosecute their studies without any break. The strength of
the each hostel will be 50 students.

2. The Government also sanction the employment of the staff and incurring of other attendant items of expenditure both recurring and non-recurring as detailed in the Annexure-I to this order for 20 new hostels from the date of employment of staff, subject to the condition that the strength of the boarders of each hostel is maintained at the same level.

3. The staff will be eligible to draw in addition to their basic pay, the Dearness Allowance and other allowances at the rates admissible to them under the orders in force.

4. The Government also accord sanction for the supply of dresses to the boarders at the rate of Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) per boarder in the High School hostels to be opened during 1993-94.

5. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are requested to arrange for the purchase of requisite variety of cloth in consultation with the Director of Handloom and Textiles, Madras.

6. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras is requested to assist the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Madras in the purchase of the requisite varieties of cloth at the lowest rate possible, having regard to the bulk orders to be placed by the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Madras as the clothes are intended for the supply to poor students.

7. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are informed that the garments should be got stitched by the tailoring units under the control of the Director of Social Welfare.

8. The expenditure shall be debited as follows:-

Staff details and other items of expenditure in both the Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities.

1. 20 Posts of B.Ed., grade Matrons in the scale of Rs.1400-40-1600-50-2300-60-2600 (10 posts under Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 10 posts under Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities).
2. 20 posts of Cooks on consolidated pay of Rs.500/-plus free meals for the period during which hostel functions (10 posts under Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 10 posts under Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities).
3. 20 posts of helpers to assist Cooks on a consolidated pay of Rs.100/-per month for the period during which the hostel functions. (10 posts under Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 10 posts of Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities).
4. 20 posts of watchman-cum-servant in the scale of pay of Rs.750-12-870-15-945 for the Girls hostel (10 posts under Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 10 posts under Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities). These posts may be filled up by redeployment wherever possible so that recurring cost of personnel is minimised.
5. Food charges at Rs.180/-per student for College Girls hostel in the City and Rs.175/-per student for College Girls hostel in Muffusil areas and Rs.120/-per student for all school Girls hostel per month from the date of opening of hostel and for the period during which the hostel functions.
6. Miscellaneous expenditure of Rs.5/-per boarder per month from the date of opening of hostels and for the period during which the hostel functions.
7. Rent not exceeding Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) per month per hostel. The rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed in consultation with public works Department authorities.

8. Vessels including 22 litres capacity Cooker and furniture for students and amenities for hostel at the rate of Rs.52,000/-(Rupees Fifty two thousand only)per hostel.
9. Mats at the rate of Rs.15/-(Rupees fifteen only)per boarder.
10. A Wet Grinder at a cost not exceeding Rs.6000/- (Rupees six thousand only)per hostel.
11. Supply of News papers viz. The Hindu and Dinamani to each Hostel.
