Order

The Government accord sanction for the opening of
14 girls and 2 boys hostels (6 Backward Classes Girls
hostels, 2 Backward Classes Boys Hostels, 7 Most Backward
Classes Girls Hostels and 1 Identified Communities Girls
Hostel) at the places as in Annexure-II to this order
during the year 1994-95 at a cost of Rs.29.84 lakhs for
1994-95 to provide boarding and lodging facilities to the
poor students of the weaker sections of the society to
pursue their studies without any break. The strength
of the each hostel will be 50 students.

2. The Government also sanction the employment of
the staff for one year from the date of employment and
incurring of other attendant items of expenditure both
recurring and non-recurring as detailed in the Annexure-I
to this order for 16 new hostels from the date of employment
of staff, subject to the condition that the strength of the
boarders of each hostel is maintained at the same level.

3. The staff will be eligible to draw in addition
to their basic pay, the Dearness Allowance and other
allowances at the rates applicable to them under the system
in force.

4. The Government also accord sanction for the supply of dresses to the boarder at the rate of Rs. 100/- (One hundred only) per boarder in the High School hostels to be opened during 1994-95.

5. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are requested to arrange for the purchase of requisite variety of cloth in consultation with the Director of Handloom and Textiles, Madras.

6. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras, is requested to assist the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Madras in the purchase of the requisite varieties of cloth at the lowest rate possible, having regard to the bulk orders to be placed by the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes & Denotified Communities, Madras as the clothes are intended for the supply to poor students.

7. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are informed that the uniforms should be got stitched by the tailoring units under the control of the Director of Social Welfare.

8. The expenditure shall be debited as follows:

1. 14 posts of B.Ed. Grade Matrons and 2 posts of B.Ed. Grade Wardens in the scale of Rs.1400-40-1600-50-2300-60-2600 (6 posts of Matrons and 2 posts of Wardens under Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 8 posts of Matrons under Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities).
2. 16 posts of cooks on consolidated pay of Rs.500/- plus free meals for the period during which hostel functions. (8 posts under Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 8 posts under Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities).
3. 16 posts of helpers to assist cooks on a consolidated pay of Rs.100/- per month for the period during which the hostel functions. (8 posts under Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 8 posts under Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities).
4. 16 posts of watchman-cum-servant in the scale of pay of Rs.750-12-870-15-945 for the Girls Hostel (6 posts under Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 8 posts under Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities). These posts may be filled up by re-deployment so that recurring cost of personnel is minimised.
5. Food charges at Rs.120/- per student for all boarders per month from the date of opening of hostel and for the period during which the hostel functions.
6. Miscellaneous expenditure of Rs.5/- per boarder per month from the date of opening of hostels and for the period during which the hostel functions.
7. Rent not exceeding Rs.1000/- (Rs. one thousand only) per month per hostel. The rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed in consultation with Public Works Department authorities.
8. Vessels, furniture and 22 litre cooker for students and amenities for hostel at the rate of Rs.61,250/- (Rs. sixty one thousand two hundred and fifty only) per hostel.
9. Mats at the rate of Rs.15/- (Rs. fifteen only) per boarder.
10. A wet grinder at a cost not exceeding Rs.6000/- (Rs. six thousand only) per hostel.
11. Supply of News papers viz. The Hindu and Dinamani to each hostel.
