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ORDER:

The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities have sent to Government Part-II proposals for opening of 15 school hostels for girls for the year 1995-96. The Government accord sanction for the opening of 14 schools girls hostels (4 Backward Classes Girls hostels, 3 Most Backward Classes Girls hostels and 1 Denotified Communities Girls hostel) at the places as indicated in Annexure-II to this order during the year 1995-96 at a cost of Rs.28.93 lakhs for 1995-96 to provide boarding and lodging facilities to the poor students of the weaker sections of the society to proceed their studies without any break. The strength of the each hostel will be 50 students.

2. Orders in respect of opening of the remaining one hostel will be issued separately.

3. The Government also sanction the employment of the staff for one year from the date of employment and incurring of other attendant items of expenditure both recurring and non-recurring as detailed in the Annexure-I to this order for 14 new hostels from the date of employment of staff, subject to the condition that the strength of the boarders of each hostel is maintained at the same level.

4. The staff will be eligible to draw in addition to their basic pay, the Dearness Allowance and other allowance at the rate admissible to them under the orders in force.

5. The Government also accord sanction for the supply of dresses to the boarders at the rate of Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred only) per boarder in the High school hostels to be opened during 1995-96.

6. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are requested to arrange for the purchase of requisite variety of cloth in consultation with the Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras.

7. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Madras is requested to assist the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and ~~Denotified~~ Denotified Communities, Madras, in the purchase of the requisite varieties of cloth at the lowest rate possible, having regard to the bulk orders to be placed by the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Madras as the clothes are intended for the supply to poor students.

8. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare/Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are informed that the uniforms should be got stitched social welfare.

9. The expenditure shall be debited as follows:-

Staff details and other item of expenditure in both the
Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and
Directorate of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities.
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1. 14 posts of B.Ed. grade Matrons in the scale of Rs.1400-40-1600-50-2300-60-2600 (4 posts of Matrons under Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 10 posts of Matrons under Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified in 14 hostels.
2. 14 Posts of cooks on consolidated pay of Rs.500/- plus free meals for the period during which hostel functions. (4 posts under Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 10 posts under Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities) in 14 hostels.
3. 14 posts of helpers to assist Cooks on a consolidated pay of Rs.100/- per month for the period during which the hostel functions. (4 posts under Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and 10 posts under Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities) in 14 hostels.
4. 14 posts of watchman-cum-servant in the scale of pay of Rs.750-12-870-15-945 for the Girls hostels in 14 hostels. (4 posts under Director of Backward Minorities Welfare and 10 posts under Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities). These posts may be filled up by redeployment so that recurring cost of personnel is minimised.
5. Food charges at Rs.135/- per student for all boarders per month from the date of opening of hostel and for the period during which the hostel is functioning for 14 hostels.
6. Miscellaneous expenditure of Rs.5/- per boarder per month from the date of opening of hostels and for the period during which the hostel functions for 14 hostels.
7. Rent not exceeding Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) per month per hostel. The rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed in consultation with Public Works Department authorities for 14 hostels.
8. Vessels, furniture and 22 litre Cooker for students and amenities for hostel at the rate of Rs.61,250/- (Rupees sixty one thousand two hundred and fifty only) per hostel for 14 hostels.
9. Mats at the rate of Rs.15/- (Rupees fifteen only) per boarder for 14 hostels.
10. A Wet Grinder at a cost not exceeding Rs.6000/- (Rupees six thousand only) per hostel for 14 hostels.
11. Supply of New papers viz. The Hindu and 'Dinathanthi' to each hostel for 14 hostels.
