SOCIAL WELFARE-Welfare of Backward Classes-Welfare of Denotified Tribes - Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Denotified Tribes - Education - Opening and maintenance of Hostels for Denotified Tribe during 1971-72-Orders issued.

Read:

From the Director of Backward Classes, Al.10/70 dated 28-9-70.

ORDER:-

The Government direct that the following new hostels for Denotified Tribes be opened with the strength of boarders noted against each and run by the Government during 1971-72.

Tirunelveli District:

1. Government Marava Hostel (Boys) at Sayanalai ... 30 Boarders.
2. Government Marava Hostel (Boys) at Veerakeralampudur ... 30 Boarders.
3. Government Marava Boarding Home at Vannichenchal ... 30 Boarders.

Madurai District:

1. Government Boys Boarding Home at Rajathani ... 50 Boarders.
2. Government Boys Boarding Home at Allinagan (theni) ... 50 Boarders.
3. Government Boarding Home (Girls) at Chelakurani ... 50 Boarders.

2. Sanction is accorded to the employment of staff from the date of appointment till 29-2-1972 and to the incurring of other items of expenditure, as detailed in the annexure to this order in respect of the new Government Hostels ordered to be opened. The Secondary Grade Wardens and B.T. Matron will be eligible to draw the usual dearness and other allowances, as admissible under the orders in force.

3. As regards sanction of building rent for the hostels the Director of Backward Classes is informed that the Collectors concerned may themselves sanction the rent up to Rs. 200/-p.m. with reference to the powers delegated to them in G.O.Ms.No. 3300 Home Dated 23-10-1964.

4. Sanction is also accorded to an expenditure not exceeding Rs. 8,600/- (Rupees eight thousand and six hundred only) towards the cost of purchase of vessels and furniture for the maintenance of the hostels sanctioned in para 1 above.

5. The expenditure is on a plan scheme eligible for Central assistance. The Director of Backward Classes is requested to include the expenditure in the quarterly statement of expenditure on plan schemes submitted by him for claiming Central assistance.

6. The expenditure should be debited to "38". Miscellaneous Social and Developmental organisations-Welfare of Scheduled Tribes, Caste and other Backward Classes-d. Development Schemes - Schemes included in the IV Five Year Plan - (i) Schemes sponsored by the Union Government with full grant (CS) Schemes under the control of the Director of Backward Classes-A. Identified Tribes."

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 98274/S3/71 dated 28-7-71.
