ABSTRACT

Welfare of Backward Classes - Education - Opening of Backward Classes Hostels for Job Oriented Trainees during 1984-85 - ORDERS - Issues.

From the Director of Backward Classes Ir. No. G3/20184/83 dated 10-11-83 and D.O. R. F2/12442/84 dated 8-5-84;

ORDER:

At present no facility is offered to help the Backward Classes candidates who are appearing for the job oriented courses such as Bank Probationary Officer's Selection Examination Course, Bank Clerk's Selection Examination Course, Business Accounts Course, etc.

2. To achieve this object, the Government have decided to select courses involving coaching less than 3 months and to sanction Rs. 500/- or the amount actually charged by the institutions, whichever is less as tuition fees to the Backward Class students admitted for the classes. The Government have also decided to open new Backward Classes Hostels for job oriented trainees with a strength of 50 candidates one for boys and another for girls, at Madras.

3. The Government accordingly sanction the opening of two Backward Classes Hostels for Job Oriented trainees during the year 1984-85. The location of hostels and their strength are detailed in the Annexure to this order.

4. The Government also sanction the employment of staff as detailed in the Annexure to this order from the date of employment or till the need there for ceases whichever is earlier and also subject to the condition that the strength of boarders of each hostel is maintained at the same level. The staff will be eligible to draw in addition to pay, the usual allowances admissible to them under the orders in force.

5. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of other items of expenditure as detailed below and as detailed in the Annexure to this order in respect of the new hostels ordered to be opened in para 3 above:-

I. Vessels:-

(i) Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) per each of the two Hostels.

(ii) Furniture:-
Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand only) per each of the two Hostels.

(iii) Cost of Library Books:-
Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) per each of the two Hostels.

II. Rent for buildings:-

Rs.1,500/- p.m. (Rupees one thousand and five hundred only) per each of the two hostels.

(The rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed by the Director of Backward Classes in consultation with the Public Works Department).

6. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of a sum of Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred only) p.m. for 12 (Twelve) months towards purchase of Newspapers and Magazines in each of the two hostels.

7. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of an expenditure of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) towards tuition fees per quarter per boy and per girl for 100 trainees (50 boys and 50 girls) as hostellers.

8. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of an expenditure of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) towards tuition fees per quarter per day scholar trainee for 50 (fifty) day scholar trainees.

9. Sanction is also accorded to the incurring of an expenditure of Rs.15/- (Rupees fifteen only) p.m. or students concessional Token system per trainee (both Hostellers and Day Scholars) whichever is cheaper towards meeting to the Travel Expenses.

10. The expenditure should be debited to "288.C.Welfare of Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes - AE.Welfare of Other Backward Classes - Schemes in the Sixth Five Year Plan - II.State Plan - KC.Backward Classes Hostel for Job Oriented Trainees(D.P.Code No.288C AEKC 0004)"

11. The Director of Backward Classes is requested to ensure that the expenditure is restricted within the provision available under Budget Estimate for 1984-85.

12. Income Limit

Students whose parents annual income do not exceed Rs.9,000/- are eligible for scheme of Job Oriented Courses.
