ORDER:

The Standing Finance Committee has cleared the Part-II proposal for opening of 25 new school hostels for Backward Classes boys/girls for the year 1998-99. The Government accord sanction for an expenditure of Rs.75.00 lakhs (Rupees Seventy five lakhs only) being the ultimate cost for the opening of 25 new school hostels (13 Backward Classes boys and 12 Backward Classes girls) to provide boarding and lodging facilities to the poor students of the weaker sections of the society to proceed in their studies without any hardship or break. The strength of each hostel will be 50 students.

2. The Government also sanction the employment of the staff from the date their employment and incurring of other attendant items of expenditure both recurring and non recurring as detailed in the Annexure-I to this order for 25 new hostels from the date of their employment, subject to the condition that the strength of the boarding of each hostel is maintained at the same level.

3. The staff will be eligible to draw, in addition to their basic pay, the Dearness Allowance and other allowance at the rates admissible to them under the orders in force.

4. The Government also accord sanction for the supply of uniforms to the boarders at the rate of Rs.125/- (Rupees one hundred and twenty five only) per boarder in the High school hostels to be opened during 1998-99.

5. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are requested to arrange for the purchase requisite variety of clothes in consultation with the Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Chennai.

6. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles, Chennai is requested to assist the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities in the purchase of the requisite varieties of clothes at the lowest rate possible, having regard to the bulk orders to be placed by the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director

of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities, Chennai -5 as the clothes are intended for the supply to the poor students.

7. The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare and Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities are informed that the uniforms should be got stitched by the tailoring units under the control of Director of Social Welfare

8. The expenditure shall be debited to the following head of account:

"2225 Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes 03 Welfare of Backward Classes 277 Education - Schemes in the Ninth Five Year Plan II - State Plan JA Backward Classes hostels (U.P. Code 2225 03 277 JA 0003)"

Staff details and other items of expenditure of Director of
Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare

1. 25 Posts of B.Ed. grade Warden/Matron in the Scale of Rs.5000-150-8000
2. 25 posts of cooks on consolidated pay of Rs.500/- plus free meals for the period during which hostel functions.
3. 25 posts of helpers to assist cooks on a consolidated pay of Rs.100/- per month for the period during which the hostel functions.
4. 12 posts of Watchmen-cum-servant in the scale of pay of Rs.2550-55-2660-60-3200
5. Food charges at Rs.225 per student for all boarders per month from the date of opening of hostels for the period during which the hostels function
6. Rent not exceeding Rs.2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) per month per hostel. The rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed in consultation with Public works Department authorities.
7. Vessels, furniture and 22 litre cooker and amenities for hostel at the rate of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand only) per hostel
8. Expenditure regarding setting up of Mini Library at Rs.2000/- per hostel
9. Mats at the rate of Rs.20/- (Rupees twenty only) per boarder.
10. Wet grinder at a cost not exceeding Rs.6500/- (Rupees six thousand and five hundred only) per hostel
11. Supply of News papers viz. 'The Hindu' 'The Dinamani' and 'Murasoli' to all the 25 hostels.
12. Miscellaneous expenditure of Rs.10/- per boarder per month from the date of opening of hostels for the period during which the hostel functions.
