ORDER:

Under Part II Schemes for 1999-2000, the Government accord sanction for opening of 5 New College hostels for Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities Boys/Girls for the year 1999-2000. The Government accord sanction for an expenditure of Rs. 22.16 lakhs (Rupees Twenty two lakhs and sixteen thousand only) (Rs. 12.93 lakhs recurring and Rs. 9.23 lakhs non-recurring) being the ultimate cost for the opening of five New College hostels (3 MBC Boys, 1 MBC Girls & 1 DNC Boys) to provide boarding and lodging facilities to the poor students of the weaker sections of the society to proceed in their studies without any hardship or break as detailed in the annexure to this order. The strength of each hostel will be 50 students. Recurring expenditure for 1999-2000 shall be restricted to the corresponding period for which the Hostels functioning from the date of their opening in the current year.

2. No staff is sanctioned towards the opening of five new Most Backward Class/Denotified Communities College hostels. The Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities is requested to manage with the existing staff available under his control.

3. The list of places for opening of 5 college hostels (3 MBC Boys, 1 MBC Girls & 1 DNC Boys) will be issued separately.

4. The expenditure shall be debited to the following head of accounts:

- 1) Food Charges at Rs.400 per student for 250 boarders per month from the date of opening of hostels for the period of 10 months during which the hostels function -Rs.10,00,000/-
- 2) Rent not exceeding Rs.2500/- (Rupees two thousand and five hundred only) per month per hostel for 5 hostels. The rent sanctioned is provisional and the actual rent should be fixed in consultation with Public Works Department authorities.
- 3) Supply of Newspaper viz. 'The Hindu' 'The Dinamani' and 'Murasoli' to all the 5 hostels.
- 4) Miscellaneous expenditure of Rs.10/- per boarder per month from the date of opening of hostels for 10 months during which the hostel functions.
- 5) Purchase of 12 Gas cylinders at Rs.150/- for each cylinder per month per hostel. (for 5 hostels - Rs.90,000/-)
- 6) Supply of insecticides at the rate of Rs.500/- per year per hostel (for 5 hostels - Rs.2,500/-)
- 7) Supply of Play materials at the rate of Rs.2000/- per year per hostel (for 5 hostels - Rs.10,000/-)
- 8) Special Festival Feast allowance for 5 festivals at Rs.3/- for each festival per boarder (for 250 boarders - Rs.3,750/-)
- 9) Purchase of Tubelight, Bucket, stationary etc. at the rate of Rs.1000/- per hostel.

Non-recurring:

- 1) Vessels, furniture and 22 litre cooker and amenities for hostel at the rate of Rs.93,000/- (Rupees ninety three thousand only) per hostel (for 5 hostels - Rs.4,65,000/-)
- 2) Mats at the rate of Rs.30/- (Rupees thirty only) per boarder (for 250 boarders - Rs.7,500/-)
- 3) Wet grinder at a cost not exceeding Rs.8,000/- (Rupees eight thousand only) per hostel (for 5 hostels - Rs.40,000/-)

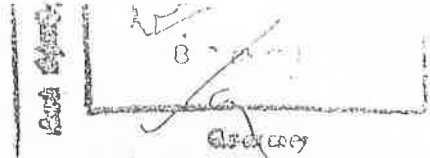
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- 4) Pillow at the rate of Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) per boarder. (for 250 boarders - Rs.25,000/-)
