ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above orders were issued for providing free bicycles to Backward Classes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities girls students studying in XI and XII standard in Government and Government aided schools during the year 2004 –2005.

2. The Honourable Chief Minister has made an announcement on 11.7.2005 extending the scheme to provide free bicycles to Boy students belonging to Backward Classes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities studying in XI and XII standard in all Government Schools / Government Aided Schools and Government Aided Schools in which +1 and +2 Courses are conducted on self financing basis (Partly aided) during the academic year 2005-2006.

3. In the letter second read above, the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare has submitted proposals for the free Supply of bicycles to Boy Students belonging to Backward Classes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities studying XI and XII Standard in Government Schools / Government aided Schools and Government aided Schools in which +1 and +2 Courses are conducted on Self financing basis. The

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Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare has reported that there are approximately about 2,86,000 Backward Classes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities Boy students, eligible for the supply of bicycles and that the cost for the supply of free bicycles to these students will be approximately Rs.57.20 crores.

4. The Government after careful examination of the proposals of the Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare pass the following orders:-

- (i) During the Academic year 2005-06 free bicycles shall be provided to 2,86,000 (approximate) Boy students belonging to Backward Classes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities studying in XI and XII standards in all Government Schools, Government Aided Schools and Government Aided Schools in which +1 and +2 courses are conducted on Self-financing basis at a total approximate cost of Rs.57.20 crore and accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.57.20 crores (Rupees Fifty seven crores and twenty lakhs only).
- (ii) Cycles shall be with standard accessories viz., PVC saddle, bell, lock, Full stand, carrier, Full Gear case and also optional accessory of Front basket and the cost per bicycle includes fitting charges and secondary freight charges. The bicycles will be delivered at the respective schools.
- (iii) The following categories of students are not eligible to receive bicycle under this scheme:
 - (a) Students staying in Residential schools and schools where the hostels and the schools are in the same campus; and
 - (b) Students who are desirous of availing free bus pass. Students who are availing free bus passes should surrender them to the Head Master / Head Mistress at the time of receiving bicycles otherwise they are not eligible to receive the bicycle.
- (iv) Cycles shall be numbered to avoid misuse.
- (v) An appropriate emblem shall be fixed to indicate that the bicycle has been issued under the Government Scheme and
- (vi) Cost of bicycle shall be recovered from the beneficiaries in the event of selling or irregular usage.

5. Purchase of bicycles shall be made centrally through the following purchase committee by observing the procedures laid down in Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and Rules, 2000 made thereunder.

1. Director, Backward Classes and - Chairman
Minorities Welfare Department.
2. Commissioner of Most Backward - Member
Classes and Denotified Communities.
3. Special Secretary to Government, - Member
Finance Department.

4. Director, Adi Dravidar Welfare Department. Member
5. Accounts Officer, Directorate of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare. Member
6. Accounts Officer, Office of the Commissioner of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities. Member
7. Joint Director of Industries and Commerce (Engineering) Member

6. Bicycles delivered shall be distributed through proper arrangements by the respective District Collectors within the specified time frame. The District Collectors can nominate an officer not below the rank of Deputy Collector / Panchayat Union Commissioner as Nodal Officer for each Taluk and ensure proper distribution and maintain registers and submit the acknowledgement with registers to the Collectors after due distribution. Respective District Collector shall make the payment for the bicycles delivered. Funds shall be allocated to the respective District Collectors who shall draw and make the payment. A committee consisting of the Commissioner of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities and Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare shall be formed for the purpose.

7. The following District Committee is constituted in each district to monitor the implementation of the Scheme :-

The meeting of the District Committee should be convened once in a week, every Monday as soon as the people grievance redressal work is over and necessary.

problems in the implementation of the scheme should be discussed, and minutes recorded and action pursued accordingly.

5. The expenditure on the purchase of bicycles is debitable to the following new Sub heads of account to be opened in Demand No.9, as detailed below:-

The Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare is the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the above new head of account.

9. The expenditure is on a "New Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature the expenditure will be met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which will be issued by the Government in Finance (BG.I) Department separately. The Commissioner of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities / Director of Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare are requested to apply in the prescribed form to Finance (BG.I) Department for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund, for their respective requirements within the overall sanction.

10. The Pay and Accounts Officers / Treasury Officers are requested to open the above new sub heads of account in their accounts.

11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.537/DS(VNP) / 05 dtd.22.7.05 and additional sanction Ledger No.427.
